


## [Access to Parent E-books from the Ottawa Catholic School Board](#)

The OCSB has added to its district e-book collection of parenting books purchased by the school board and by the OCSB Parent Involvement Committee (PIC).

There are parenting books as well as children's books you may want to read with your child. More books will be added to the collection.



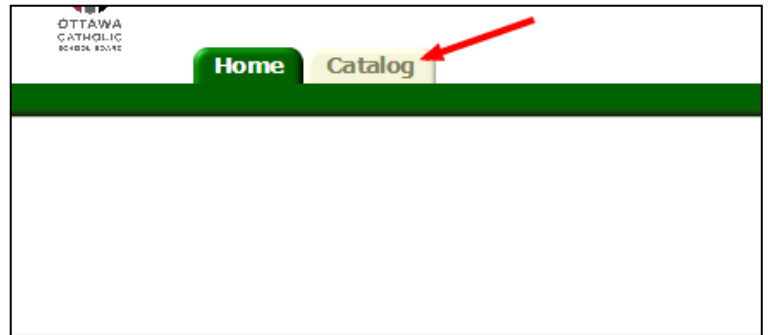
**Click on the "+"** and use the drop down menu to choose a school from the list of "Elementary Schools" or "High Schools".

Note: All schools have the same selection of parenting e-books.



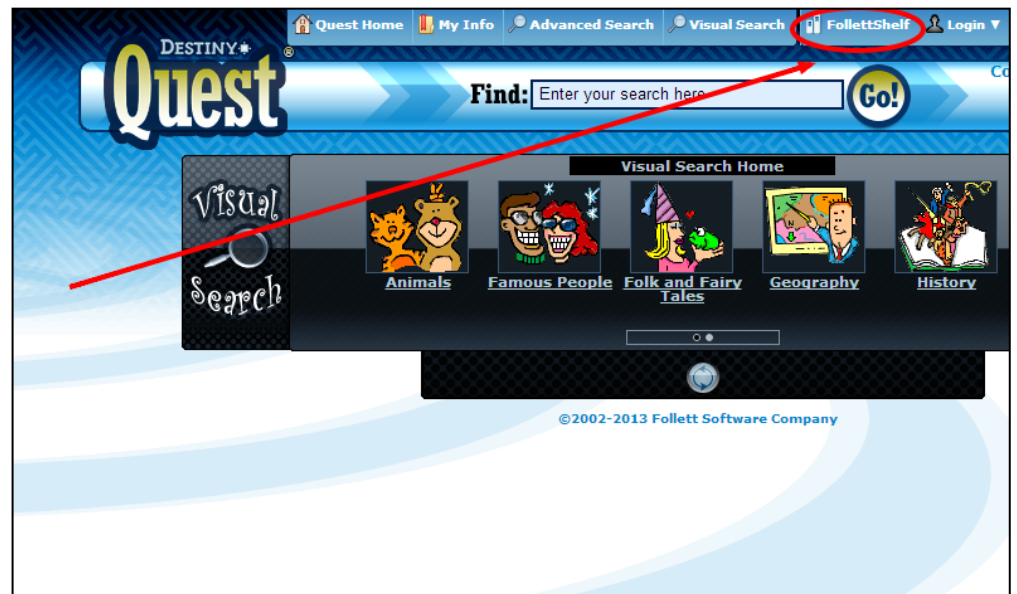
E-books are stored on the “FollettShelf”
